August 21, 2024 Board Meeting

Meeting held virtually

In Attendance: John Amery, Carol Mauser, Larry Russ and Debby Jones

Guest: Hayle Riach

Carol opened the meeting at 7:02

Item 1 - Approval of Agenda: Carol asked for approval of the August agenda. John moved to approve the agenda as presented. Larry seconded. All approved, motion carried.

<u>Item 2 – Approval of Minutes:</u> Carol asked for approval of the July meeting minutes. Larry made the motion to approve Budget Hearing and the July minutes. John seconded. All approved, motion carried.

Water Delivery Program

Hayle joined the meeting to update the board on the water delivery efforts. There are now 38 Tooley Water District members utilizing the service. Program appears to be going very well. People can contact Hayley at 541-556-0184 / Hayley.p.riach@odhs.oregon.gov

Item 3 - Financial Reports:

Checking account balance \$ 9,148.54Money Market balance \$68,105.16

John notified that the bank has increased their fees if there is balance below \$5,000. We had fallen slightly below the threshold. John was able to have the bank reverse the fee explaining that we were not aware of the new balance threshold. John provided financial updates including checks and deposits. It was noted that NW Natural Water has a new way of identifying maintenance charges on the invoices. John shared that the Sensaphone charge was actually for last year and this year due to a billing error on the company.

Item 4 - Discussion - Water Report:

• Water report 6.65% water loss.

Item 5 – Discussion – Nitrate Resolution Plan:

- OHA Agreement signed on 6/20/24
- Tooley water district has until 9/20/24 to submit i's action plan
- Board members Amery and Mauser attended the monthly meeting. Updates were provided on the two potential financial resources that the district is looking at. The EPA is funding a detailed engineering report, which will be more detailed that the previous report. There will be a field study next Wednesday. After this report is completed, the board should have a more accurate project cost number. John suggested that if there was a large amount needed, a bond might be a better option as opposed to a loan.
- John made the motion to authorize Chairperson Mauser the authority to negotiate a

contract with GSI up to \$4,000 for the purpose of managing Tooley Water District's request for water rights at the new well site. Larry seconded. All approved. Motion carried.

Item 6 – Discussion/Action – General System Updates:

John mentioned that the EPA contact is scheduled to be in the area next week. Larry had
received a letter from ODA, which stated that an additional soil sample had been taken but a
report had not been received. Board members discussed the recent application of materials
on the fields.

Item 7 – Discussion – Delinquent Accounts:

 Board discuss adjustments that NW Natural had made. Appears that meters had been misread.

Item 8 - Tooley Road Association:

 NW Natural Water is still automatically paying the road account even if a customer is not up to date with payments. Debby will follow-up with Devin again. John also wanted to make sure that customers were clear that their water would not be turned off if their road fee had not been paid.

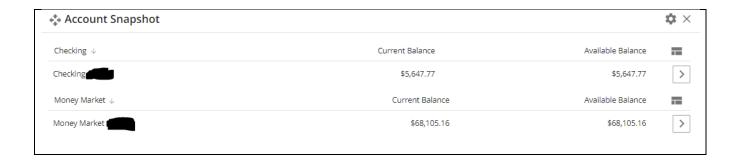

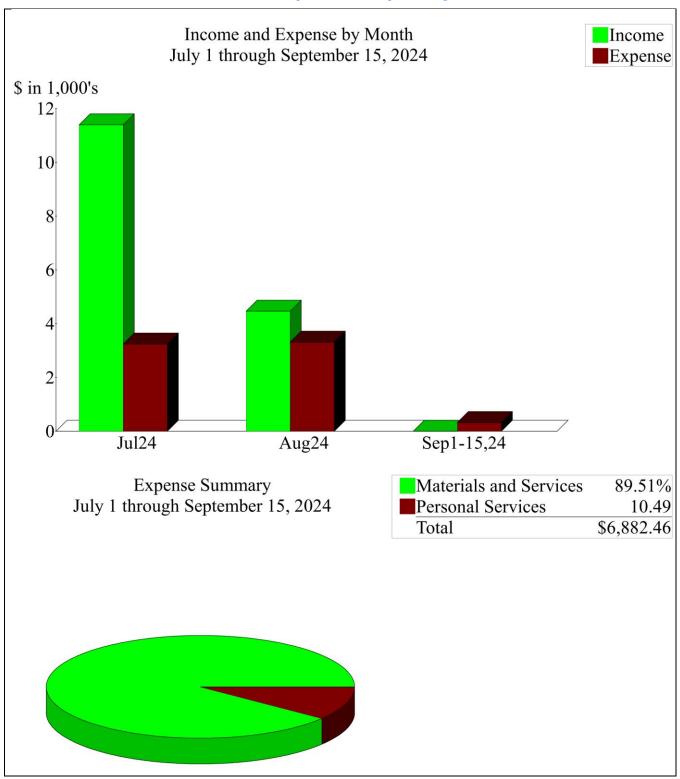
